CONFESSIONS DURING HOLY WEEK: There will be many opportunities to receive the Sacrament of Penance during Holy Week. Please note the extended confession times on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday in the timetable. Confession times are strict, so please allow plenty of time and be mindful of other people while making your confession.



PALM SUNDAY: Palms will be blessed at 7:30am on Palm Sunday, **March 29th**. If you have palms that you would like to donate, please bring them either to the sacristy, or the Church on the morning. **Please note that Palms will only be blessed at the 7:30am Mass.** Blessed Palms will be available for the community to collect at the Grotto after that 7:30am Mass.



CHRISM MASS: The annual Chrism Mass will be at 7.00pm on **Tuesday, March 31st** at St. Mary's Cathedral. At this Mass, the Holy Oils will be blessed and the Chrism will be consecrated. The Oils and Chrism from this Mass are used in Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation in the Archdiocese of Perth. Everyone is welcome to attend this Mass.

Questions on Music & Liturgy: How can the Congregation participate in the singing during the Triduum?


There is a rich body of liturgical music—prayers that are integral to the liturgy of these three most solemn days—to be sung during the Triduum. While some of this is proper to the choir, there is still much that the congregation can, and ought, to sing.

In addition to the Mass Ordinaries (Kyrie, etc.) on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday, there is the Pange Lingua sung in procession to the Altar of Repose on Maundy Thursday; the threefold Venite adoremus at the Veneration of the Cross on Good Friday; and, at the Easter Vigil, both the responses to the Litany of Saints and the threefold Alleluia—sung between the Epistle and the Gospel, and again at the singing of Lauds after Communion.

All of these are set out in the liturgy booklet for the week, and everyone is warmly invited to join in this important liturgical singing.
