Questions on Music & Liturgy: What is the historical evidence for the sung liturgy in parishes of the Archdiocese of Perth before the Second Vatican Council?

Although there is a rich range of historical sources in relation to the teaching of plainchant in Catholic schools, largely through the efforts of the Diocesan Director of Music, Fr Albert Lynch, the evidence for regular sung Masses in parishes (as distinct from religious houses and


the Cathedral) and, in particular, with the sung propers of the *Graduale Romanum*, is limited. The sacred music regulations published by Fr Lynch for the Archdiocese (1939) provide for the possibility of singing portions of the Ordinary of the Mass at Low Mass and that children, having been taught a Gregorian Mass, be provided with opportunities to sing a Missa Cantata 'occasionally'.

Dom Stephen Moreno OSB's Gregorian Manual, published at New Norcia in 5 editions from 1941 onwards, gives some indication of what the practices in many places probably were, providing a simple guide for singing the propers of the Mass to a psalm tone (that is, how the Divine Office is usually sung with its simple melodic formulas). Although Moreno did not set out the propers for individual feasts, Fr Percy Jones's 1952 'Hymnal of Blessed' (and later Saint) Pius X' provided accompanied settings for the propers of the Church's major feasts, but with the chants between the readings set to psalm tones.

A comprehensive study of the musical practices in the Archdiocese in this period (and the reasons for these) will require significant research. Nevertheless, a picture emerges that, despite the Church's clear preference for the sung liturgy as the ordinary form of parish worship – with low mass the exception – the reverse has been the case in this and many other dioceses in Australia.
